And made a perfect ball.



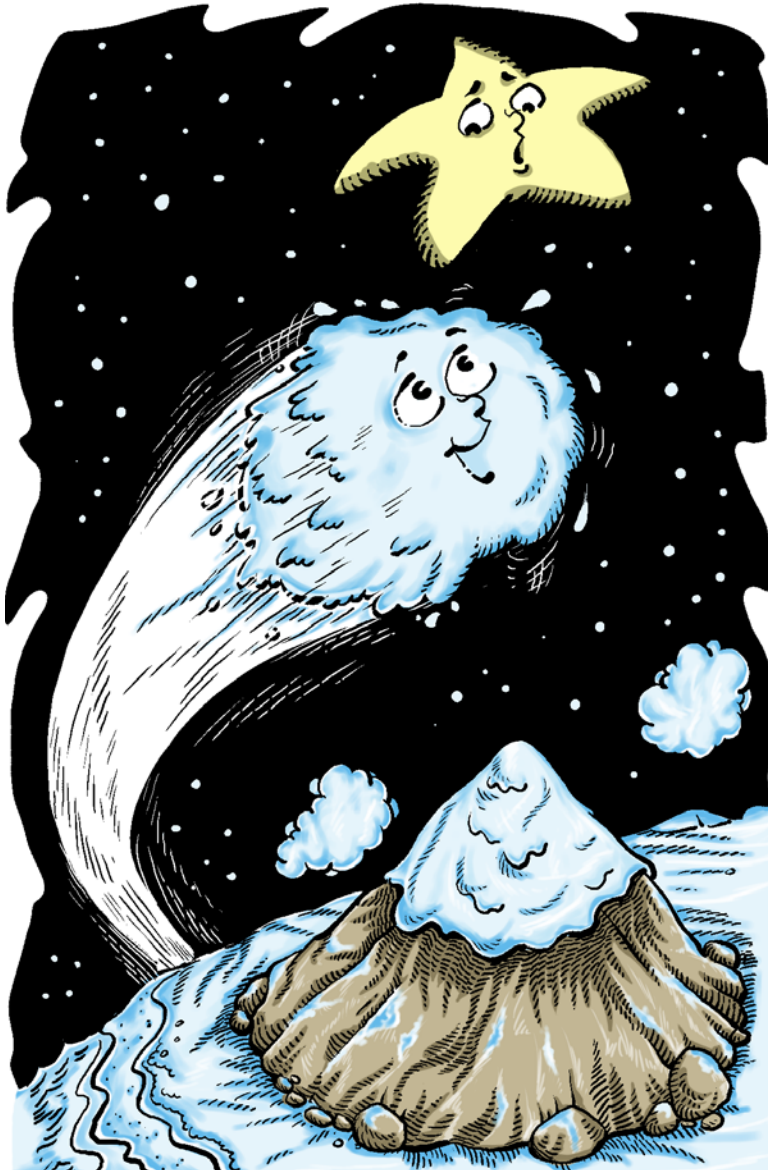
I rolled it in my mittens

Who chased it on its way.



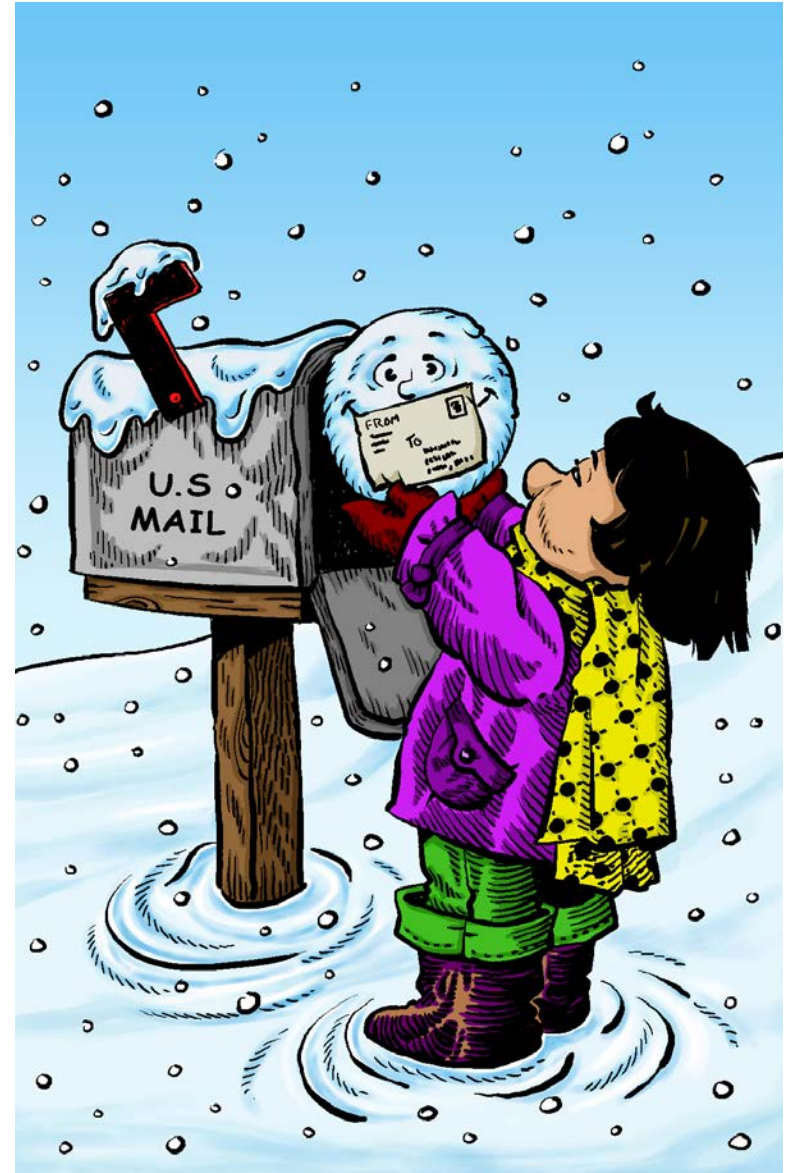
It whizzed beyond a mountain,
